Welcome to Edgbaston, the home of Warwickshire County Cricket Club since 1886. The ground has hosted international cricket for over a century since its maiden Test match in 1902 and it has been a venue for some of the biggest games in world cricket, including multiple Ashes series, ICC World Cup fixtures and ICC Champions Trophy matches, including the final in 2013.

It's a ground England have enjoyed success at in recent years, with the national side going unbeaten at the venue in all formats since 2014 – a stretch that has seen nine victories in a row

Edgbaston last hosted a major tournament in 2017 when it staged five matches including India versus Pakistan, and the second semi-final between Bangladesh and India.
